Pittarak Kayaks are handmade in the Shoalhaven, NSW South Coast. Pricing for fully fitted out expedition Sea Kayak's are:

- **Single Classic** - Carbon Kevlar \$4900 with either rudder or skeg; and
- **Double Classic** – Carbon Kevlar \$5900 with rudder.

**Note: freight is additional, and pricing is subject to change due to materials costs;

- Larry Gray designed deck and hull that provides multiple 'active control' surfaces, constructed of the most advanced laminates capable of withstanding the stresses and temperatures of extreme sea kayaking from the polar regions to the tropics.
- Full 6mm safety deck lines, 5mm shock cords and haulage handles.
- Three fully sealed compartments with access via the highest grade VCP hatches.
- Option of the retractable skeg or the unique removable rudder system with easily adjustable foot controls constructed of marine grade materials.
- Efficient, reliable bilge system.
- Customising with accessories such as a compass or towing points is also available.

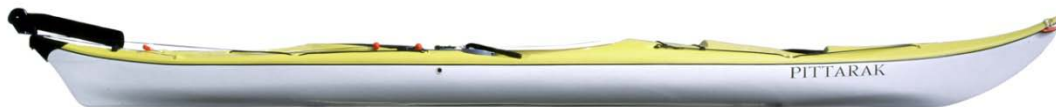

This elegantly crafted sea kayak is designed by Larry Gray to provide a fast, responsive craft for paddlers of all skill levels. Its high bow slices cleanly through rough seas while its low profile in the water provides excellent stability and control in a wide variety of ocean conditions. The side profile of the hull is designed to lever the keel out of the water during extreme edging to allow the kayak to pivot on the spot with minimal paddle strokes. Uncompromised strength in construction provides long term durability and confidence in extreme conditions. Innovative deck and cockpit configuration provides comfort and functionality for the paddler on extended journeys.

This elegantly crafted sea kayak is designed by Larry Gray to provide a fast, responsive craft for paddlers of all skill levels. Its high bow slices cleanly through rough seas while its low profile in the water provides excellent stability and control in a wide variety of ocean conditions. The cockpit spacing allows for effective control when in rough seas by allowing the rear paddler to easily reach the main control points of the kayak while the front paddler is positioned to allow maximum bow control. The double is famous for its stability in rough conditions and the capacity to roll up if capsized. Uncompromised strength in construction provides long term durability and confidence in extreme conditions. Innovative deck and cockpit configuration provides comfort and functionality for the paddlers on extended journeys.
